

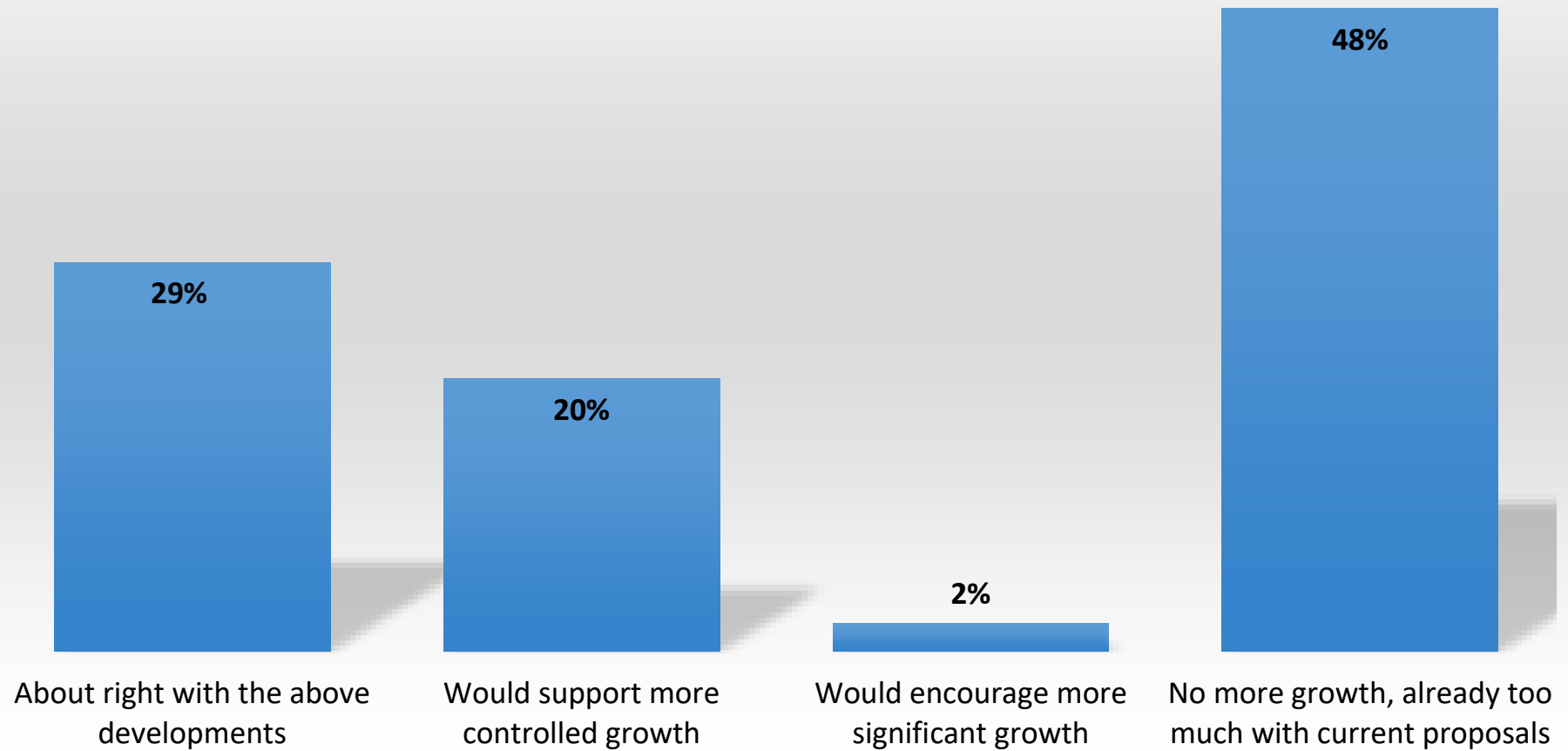

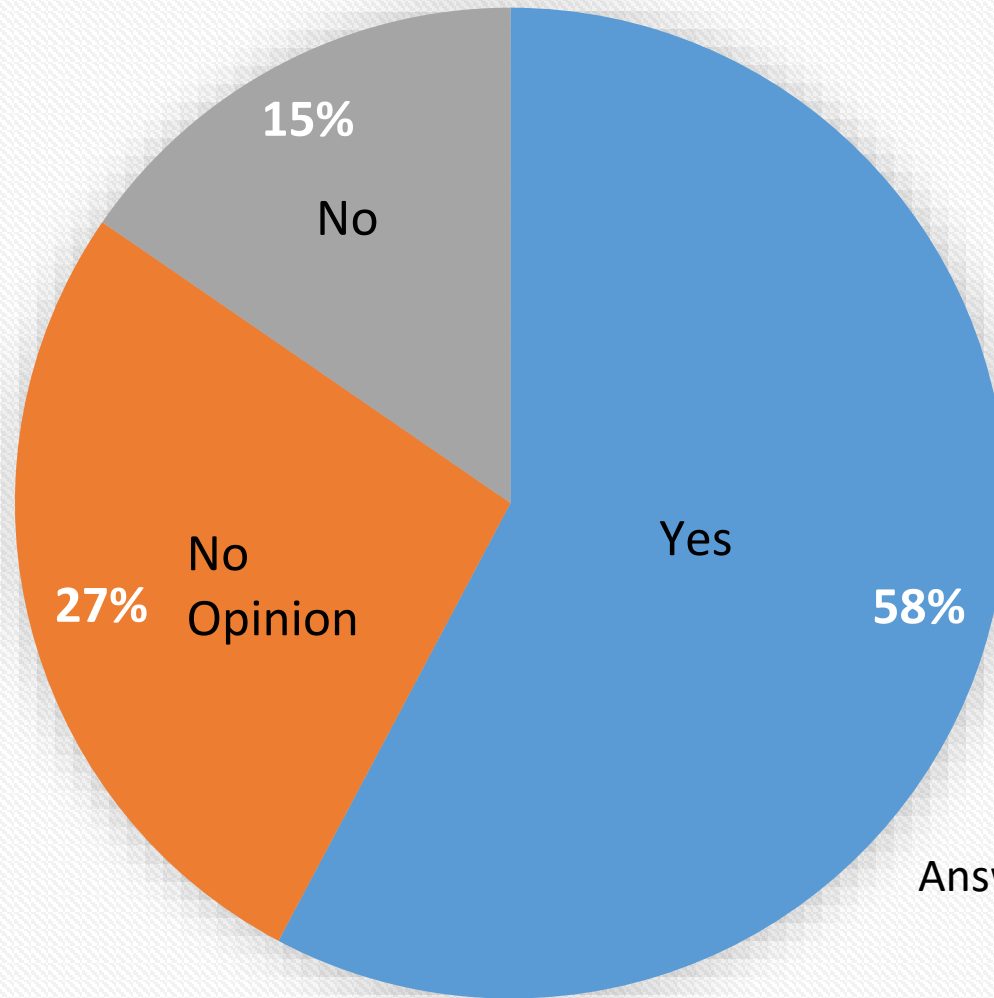

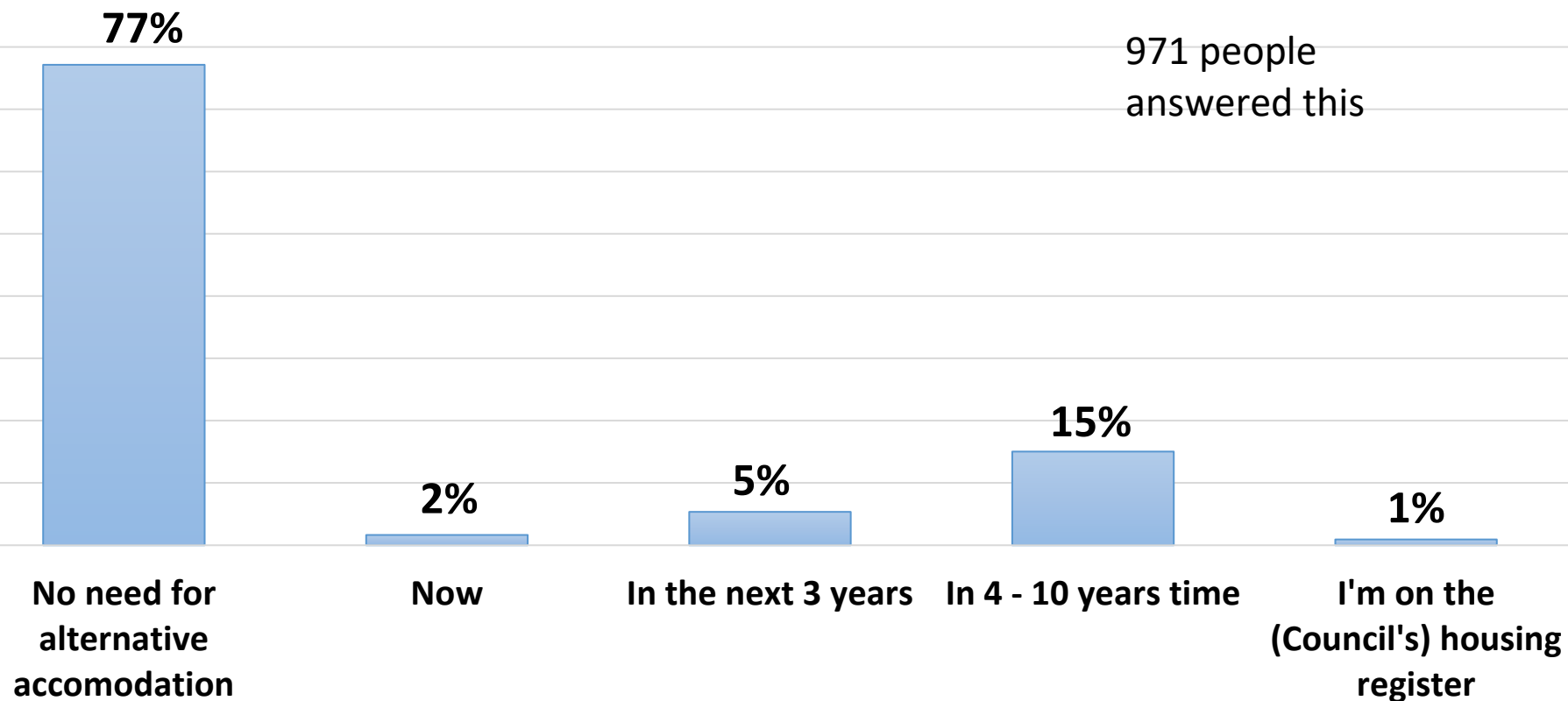


Q8 Would you support your Neighbourhood Plan allocating sites for Affordable Housing?



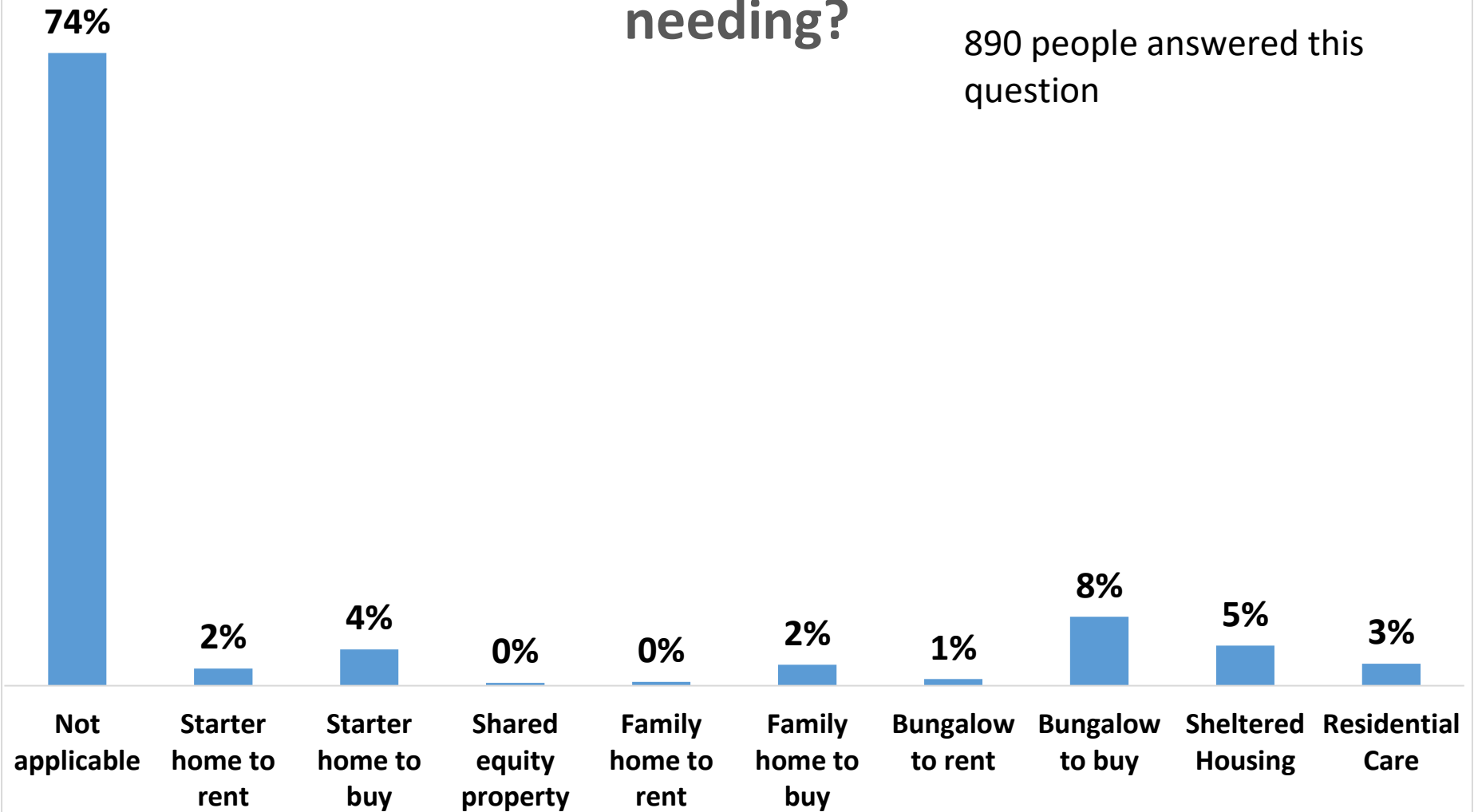

Q9 Do you anticipate to have a need for alternative accomodation in Great Barton, now or within the next 10 years?

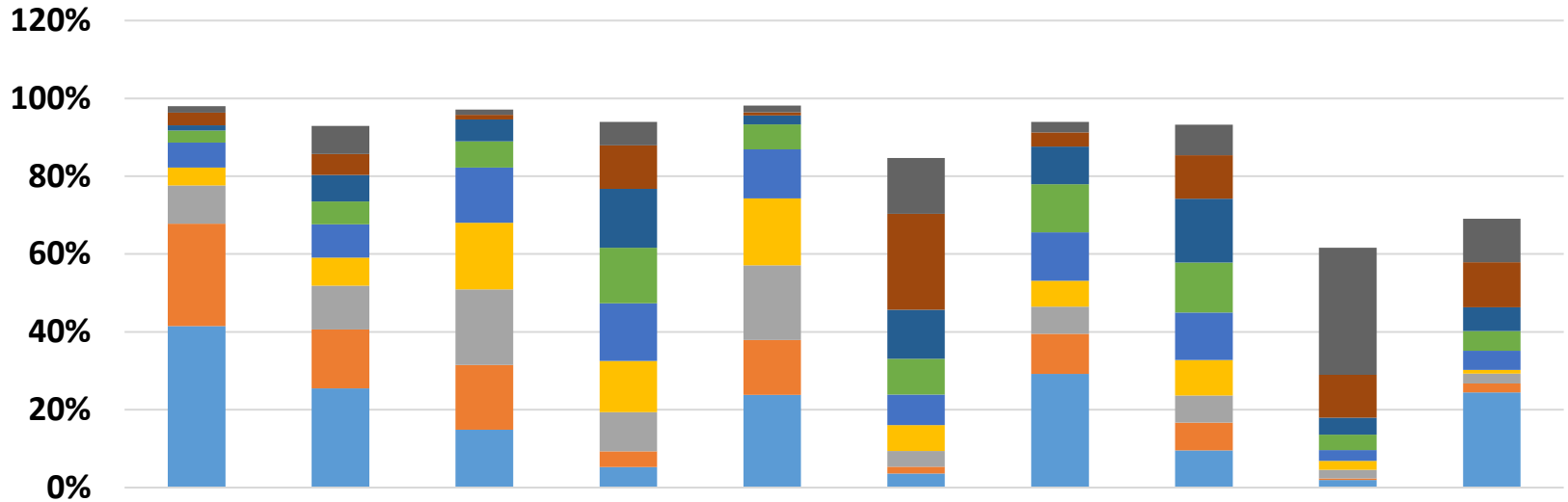


Q10 What type of accomodation will you be needing?

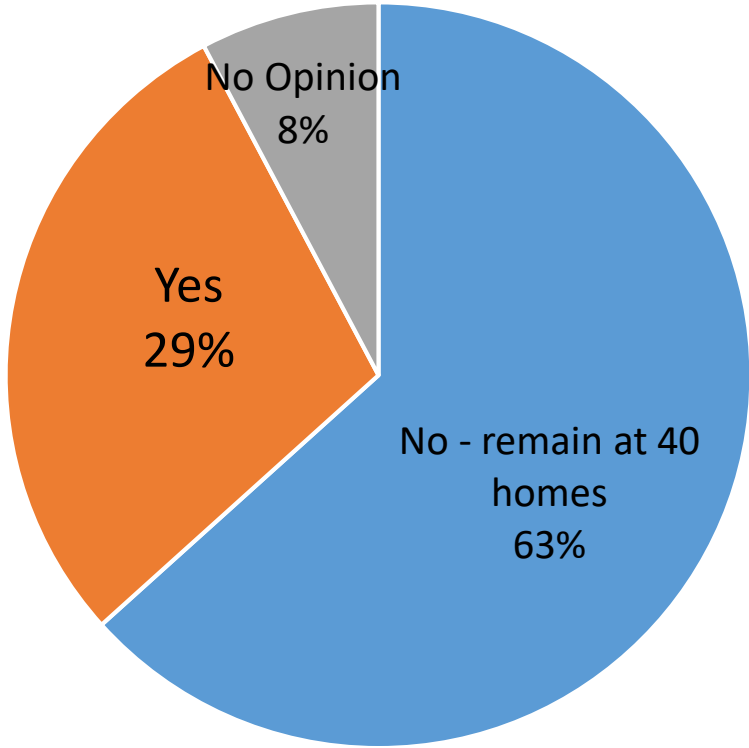
Q11 What types of homes would you prefer across the Parish?

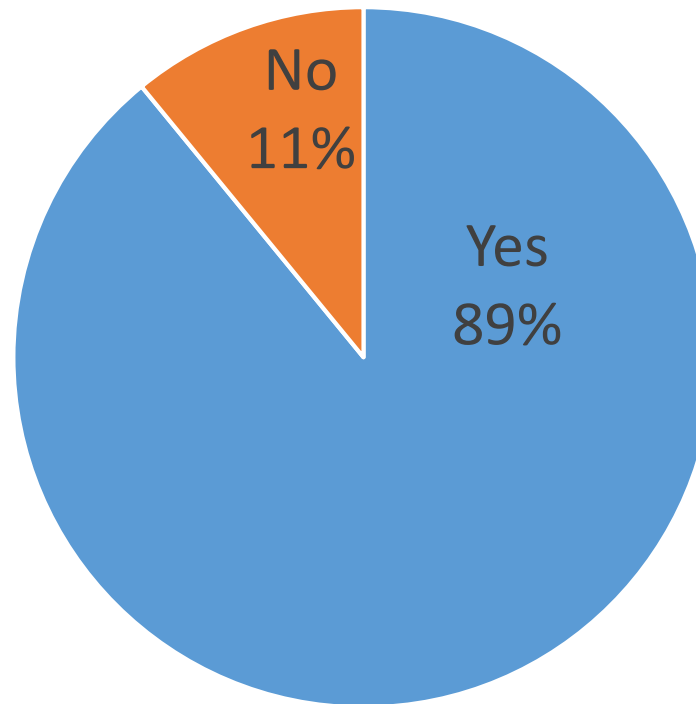

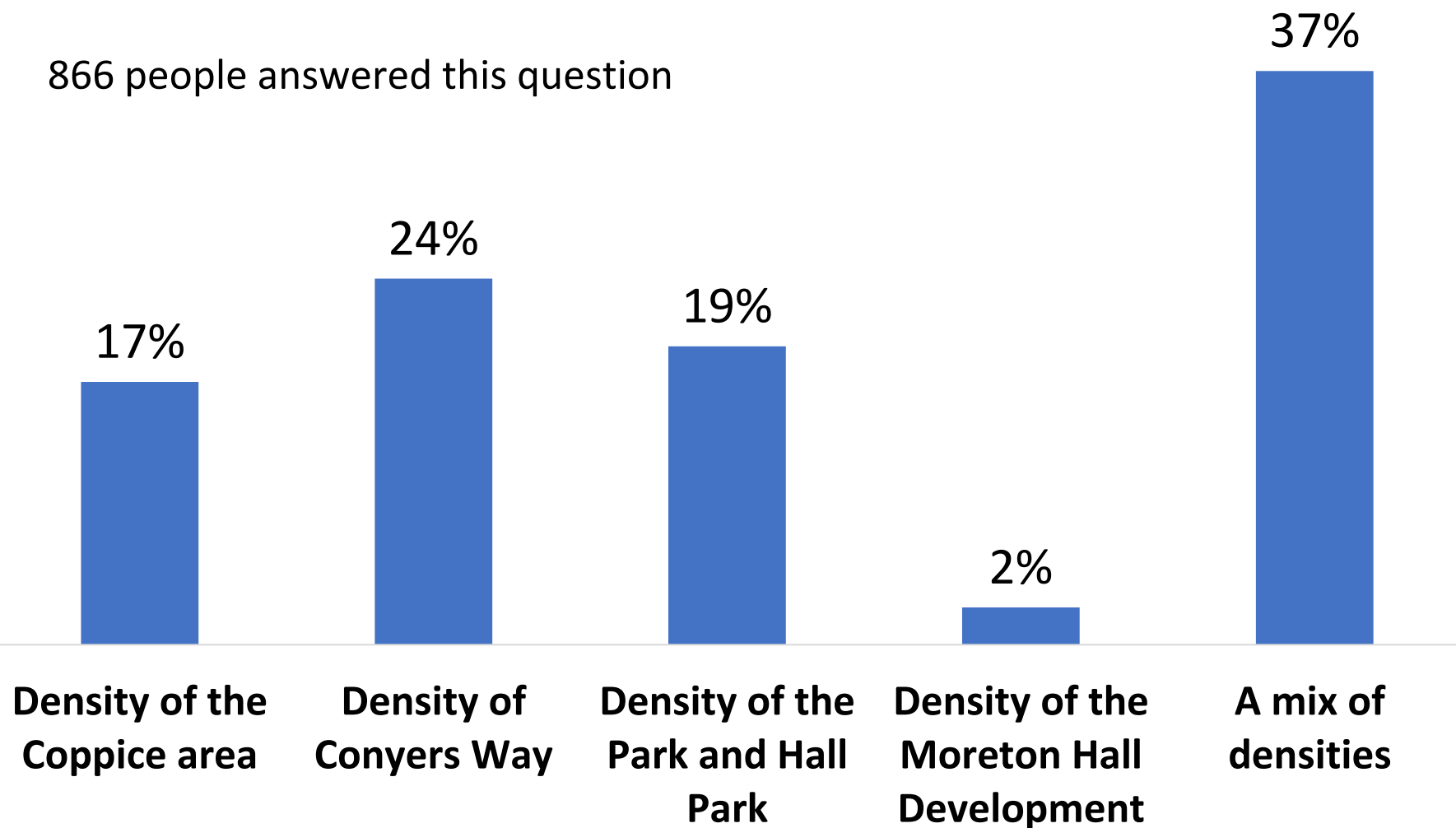
Q14 Should the Neighbourhood Plan include specific garden sizes and minimum separation distances to maintain current housing densities as typifies Great Barton?

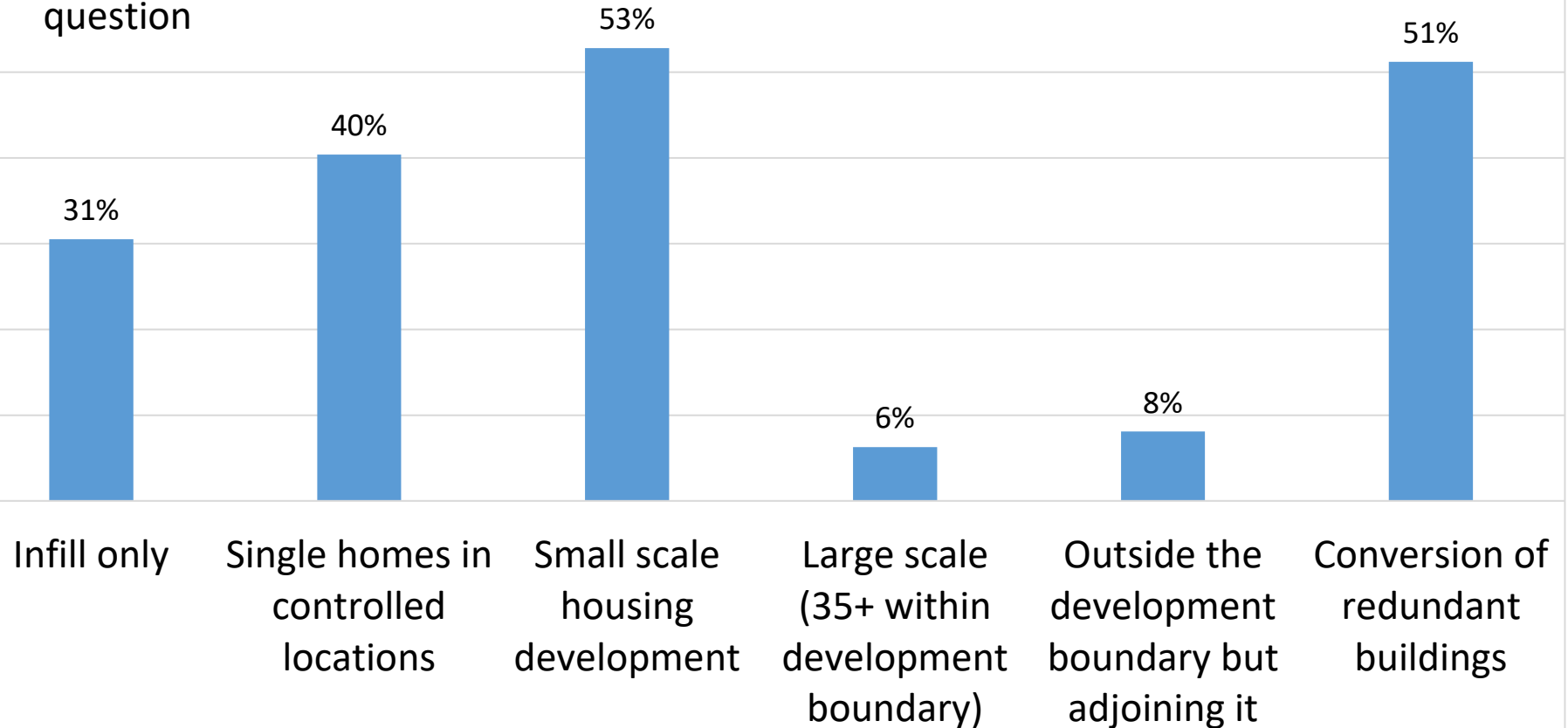
Q15 If yes to Qu 14 what would be your density preference?

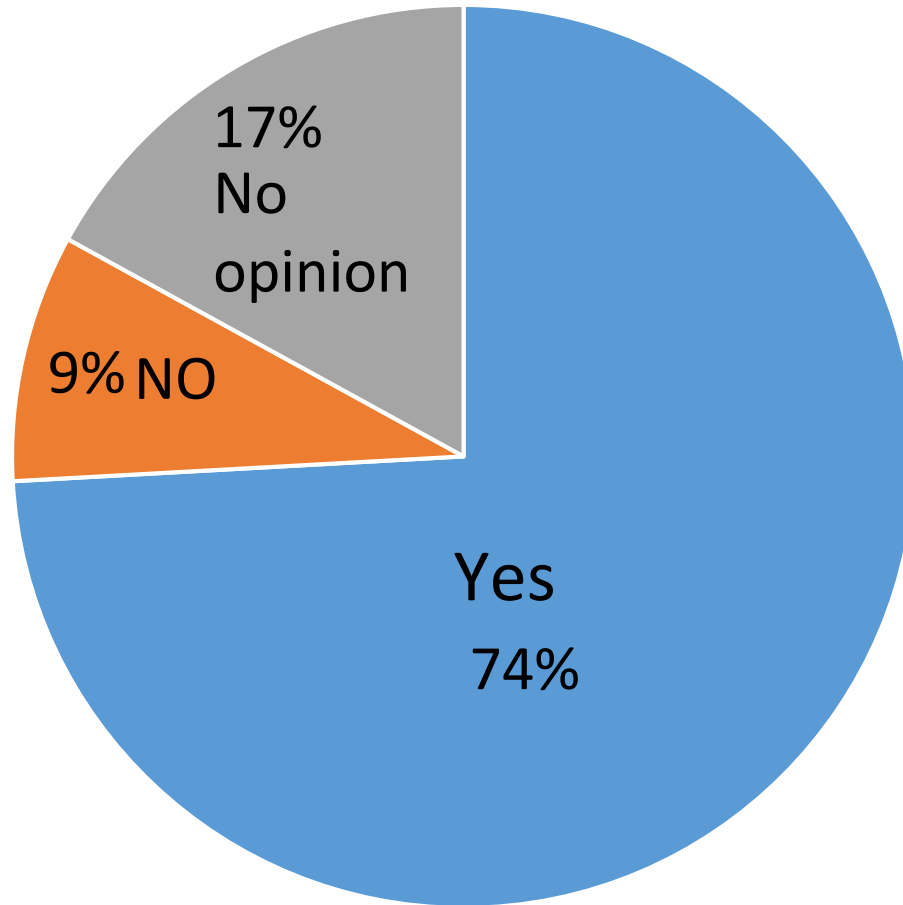


Q16 What type of housing development would be acceptable to you in Great Barton?
