

Executive Summary & Key Findings

Great Barton Parish Council carried out a Housing Survey to determine the level of need for housing across all tenure types in the parish.

The aim of this survey was to understand the existing and future housing needs for Great Barton residents including family members (not necessarily living in Great Barton) and other members of the household. The study was also designed to understand Great Barton current housing stock and whether this is affordable to local people.

This study included-

- General information about the current housing in Great Barton including 2011 Census data
- A Housing Survey to determine the housing needs of current households
- Contextual information about Great Barton
- Information from the Home-Link register to cross check the findings

Data analysis and the writing of this report have been undertaken by Community Action Suffolk.

The Great Barton Housing Survey 2017 achieved a 52.66% return rate, with respondents in favour of homes for older people, small family homes and homes for couples.

From the 465 surveys returned, 56 households responded that the current households have identified a current need totalling 90 people.

From the 465 surveys returned, 24 of those households responded identifying a need for 45 family members (people with a local connection) wishing to live in or return to Great Barton.

In total, the response from 80 households identified a housing need for 135 people in Great Barton. This report has been compiled based solely on the data from the responses received. These figures may change throughout the report depending on the number of questions completed.
